Ticks spin a greater web of danger

ALMOST no one likes spiders. It takes a special someone to appreciate these creatures and although they do enormous good in our environment they remain a scary mystery to most of us, famous only for their webs and fearful bites.

Spiders are part of the arachnid family which covers everything on eight legs - spiders, scorpions, ticks and mites. Little is known about the effect on animals of bites from the vast majority of Queensland spiders but few spiders are considered to be highly dangerous to pets.

Redbacks and funnel webs are the best known exceptions. Of all the spiders in Queensland these two are the ones likely to cause serious illness and death.

Redbacks are the more common of the two and dogs, cats, horses and guinea pigs are occasionally bitten. Any animal bitten requires immediate veterinary assistance. Happily for dogs, it is thought they are more resistant to the redback venom than some other animals.

A bite from any spider may potentially cause problems for animals but with luck a little redness, soreness and temporary swelling may be all that the animal has to worry about.

Having said that, allergic reactions are quite common after bites and unfortunately it is also common for the culprit to remain unidentified, in other words you never know for sure what has caused the bite - it could be a spider, a mite, or an insect such as an ant.

If the culprit is not identified the more dangerous outcomes have to be taken into consideration.

Immediate first aid for any suspected bite should include applying some ice to the bitten area rather than bandages, wrapping the animal in a warm blanket and seeking urgent veterinary attention.

Although seriously venomous, spiders are less likely to cause problems for pet animals on a regular basis than some of their close relatives such as mites and ticks.

Various kinds of fur, ear and feather mites frequently cause great misery for dogs, cats and pet birds and the paralysis ticks are about to start hatching for the year, thriving in Queensland's warm, moist climate.

Signs of tick paralysis include loss of movement in the back legs and any suggestion of breathing problems, unwillingness to move, loss of appetite, coughing or vomiting. Medical treatment for tick paralysis is more likely to be successful if the treatment is begun sooner rather than later.

Although spiders get the horror-movie reputation it is the paralysis tick branch of the arachnid family that causes far more trouble and more often.

Obama regrets race row



Tourist line: Rescuers help injured passengers, which include two Australians, from a Croatian train derailment

Aussies hurt in train crash

ZAGREB: A two-car train carrying about 90 passengers has derailed in rough terrain in southern Croatia, killing six people and injuring at least 55, including two Australians.

The high-speed train — travelling from Zagreb, Croatia's capital, to the coastal city of Split — derailed in a remote, hilly area at about midday on Friday, 30km from its

destination, emergency official Darko Marinkovic said.

The impact nearly broke one of the two cars in half, leaving a gruesome tangle of metal, seats, blood and passengers' possessions. Six people were killed and at least 55 injured, Mr Marinkovic said.

Medical teams and helicopters raced to the scene to carry the injured to local hospitals.

Among the injured were 12 foreigners: four French citizens, two Australians and one each from Slovenia, Sweden, Britain, Pakistan, Serbia and Spain, an emergency official said.

Five suffered minor injuries and were released from hospital, while others were kept for treatment, the official said.

The cause of the derailment was being investigated.

WASHINGTON: Trying to defuse an uproar over race, President Barack Obama says he used an unfortunate choice of words in commenting on the arrest of black student, Henry Gates.

The President said he had telephoned the white policeman who arrested Mr Gates and the conversation confirmed his belief that the officer was a good man and an outstanding policeman.

Mr Obama caused a stir when he said at a prime-time news conference last week that police in Cambridge, Massachusetts had "acted stupidly" by arresting Mr Gates, a Harvard University scholar and friend of the President, for disorderly conduct.

On Friday at a White House briefing, Mr Obama attempted to contain the controversy.

He said he continued to believe that both the officer, Sergeant James Crowley, and Mr Gates had overreacted during the incident, but the President also found fault with his own comments.

"This has been ratcheting up,

and I obviously helped to contribute to ratcheting it up," he said.

"I want to make clear that in my choice of words, I think I unfortunately gave an impression that I was maligning the Cambridge police department and Sgt Crowley specifically.

"And I could've calibrated those words differently."

Police went to Mr Gates's home last week after a passer-by reported a possible break-in, but it turned out Mr Gates had tried to force open his own door, which was stuck.

Mr Gates protested the police actions and was arrested, although charges were dropped.

Before the President's White House briefing, a multi-racial group of police officers stood with Sgt Crowley in Massachusetts and asked Mr Obama and the state's black Governor, Deval Patrick, to apologise for comments they said were insulting.

Mr Patrick had described Mr Gates's arrest as "every black man's nightmare".

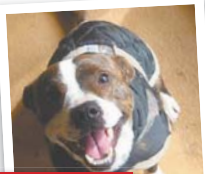
