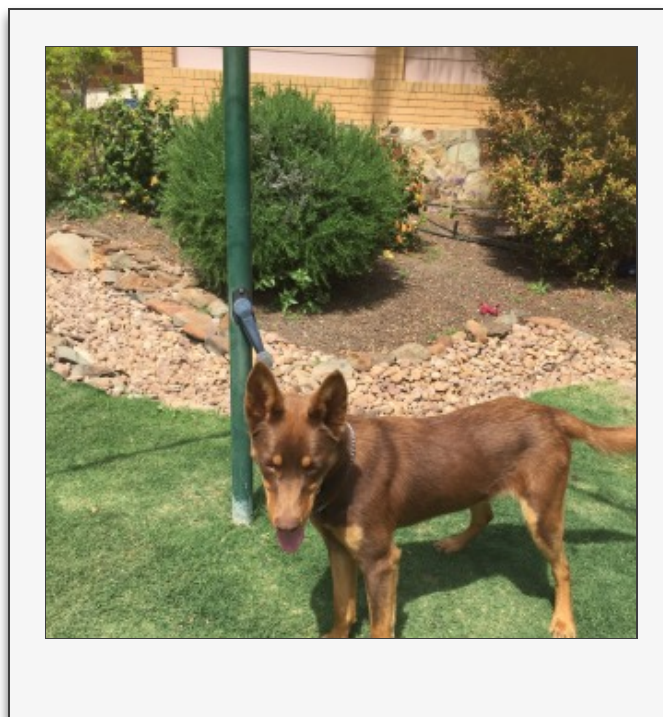


# Hi, my name is Yankee
