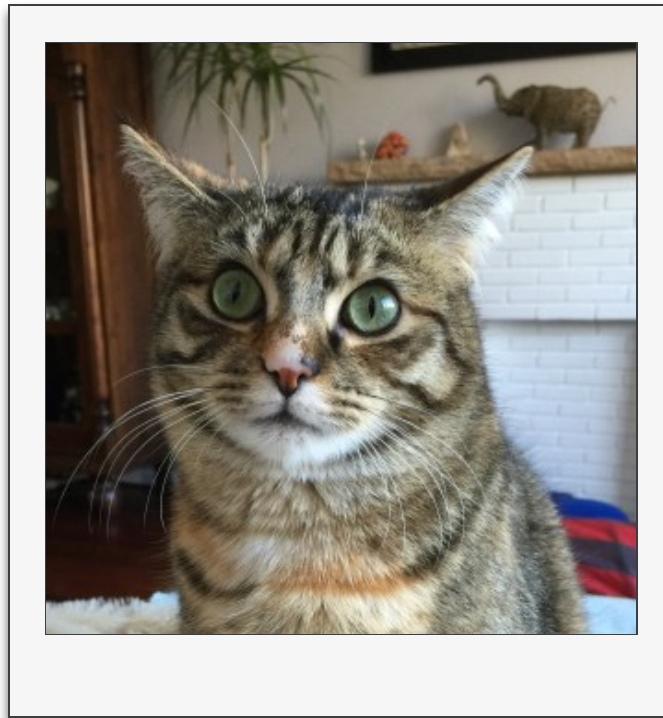


# Hi, my name is Fiammetta

What this means is she has poor cognition of what's happening on her left hand side. It's caused by damage to the right side of her brain. Words from her carer "I spent a year teaching her all the things she needs to know to be a normal cat, like how to walk, how to play and how to climb. She has now passed her "training" with an A+!!" "Fia" as she is known for short, needs an understanding owner, where she can feel safe. She needs a secure home, preferably fully indoors although supervised access to an enclosed courtyard would be acceptable. She took time to accept the resident adult cat but has connected immediately with every other foster kitten...
