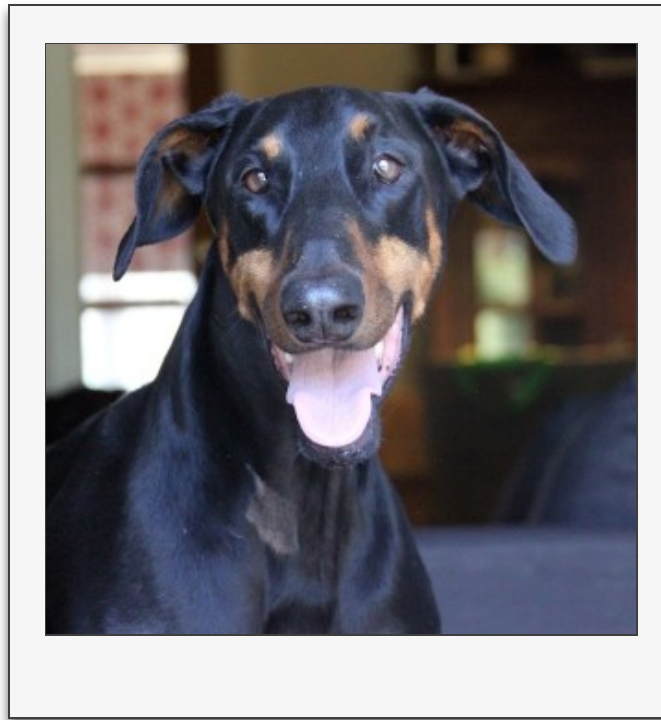


# Hi, my name is Rosie (& Sheikh)
