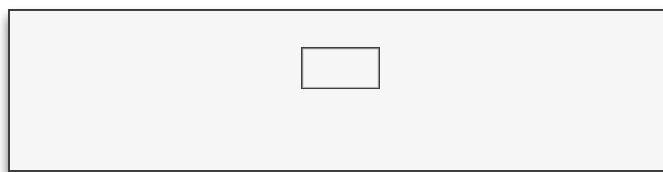


# Hi, my name is Ginny
