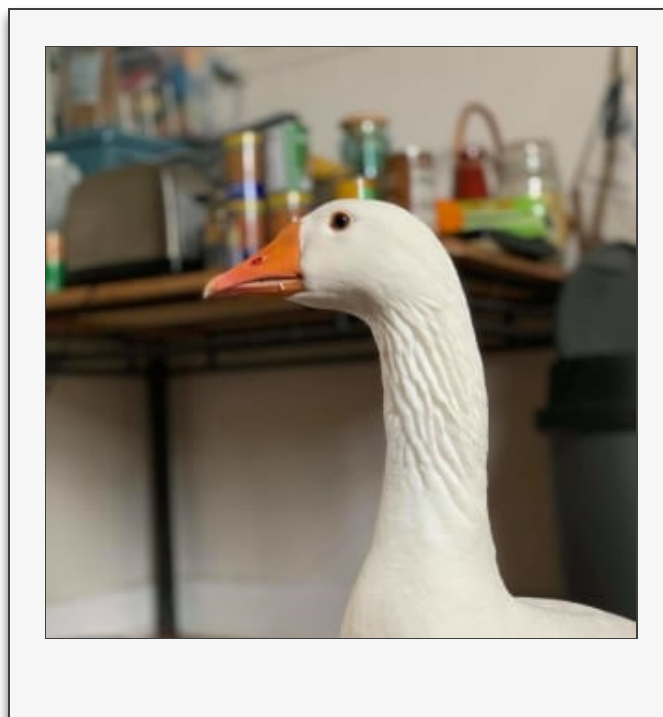


Hi, my name is Wanda
