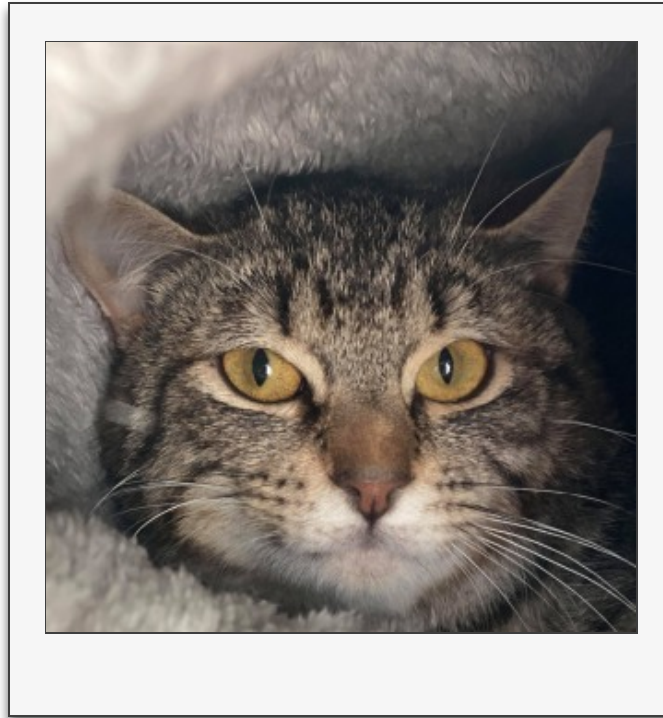


Hi, my name is Binx (Located In Caulfield South) Potential to Shine!
