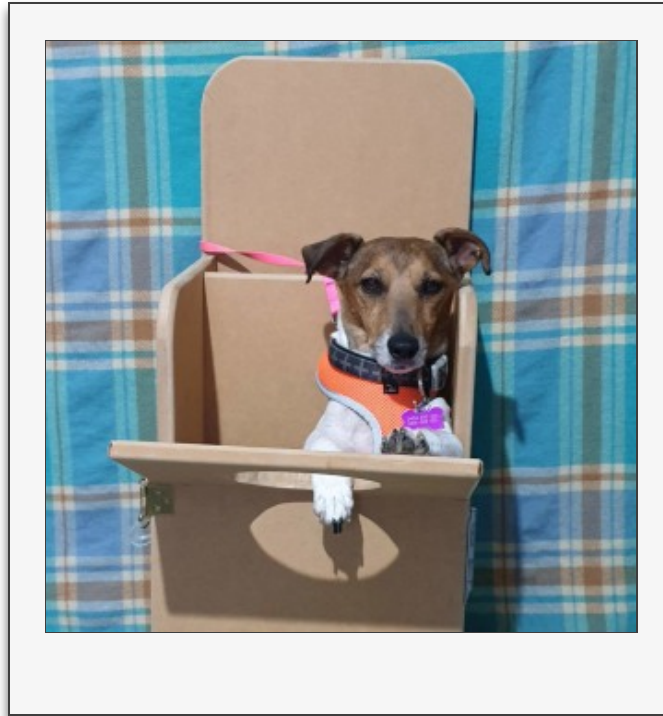


# Hi, my name is Mack
