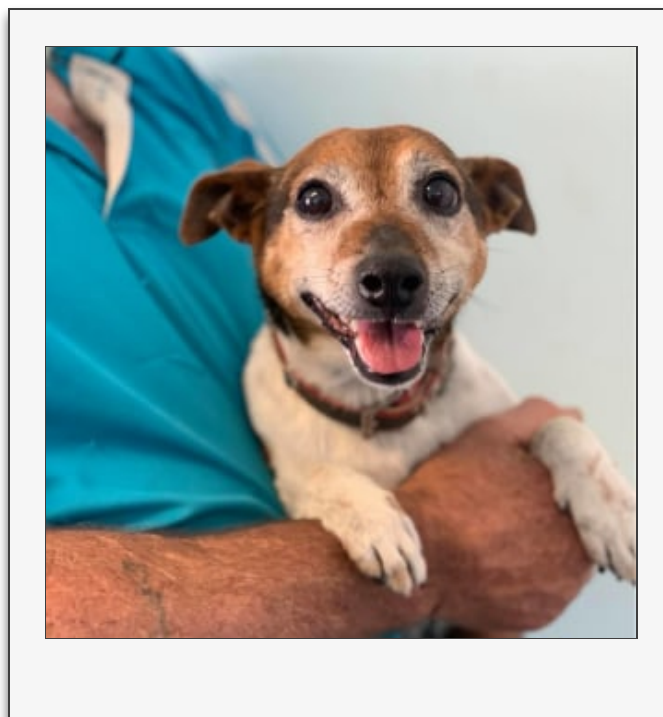


Hi, my name is Marty
