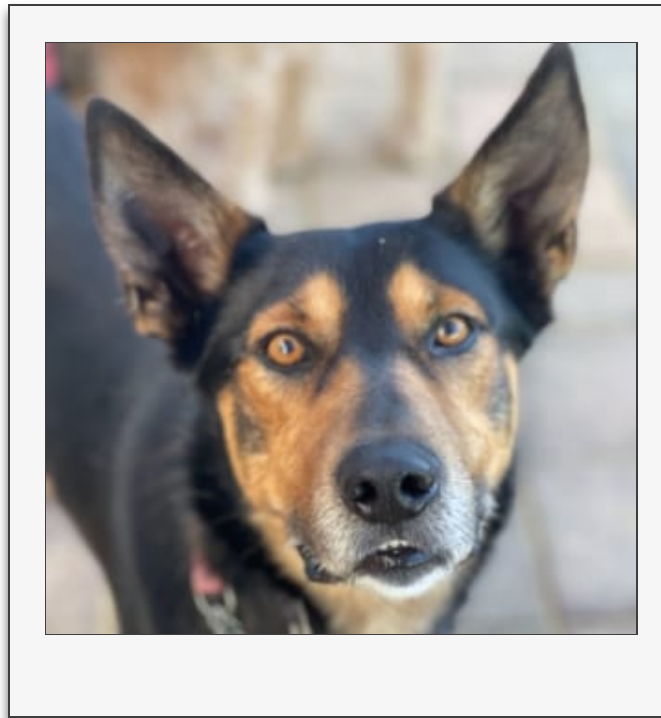


Hi, my name is Max
